

THE JOYFUL NOISE CHOIR
Is For Kids Who LOVE To Sing!

If you are thinking about joining the Joyful Noise, here are some things you should know:

- Joyful Noise is a mixed choir (boys and girls) organized in three sections:
 - Junior Choir (grades 3 & 4)
 - Intermediate Choir (grades 5 & 6)
 - Senior Choir (grades 7 & 8)
- Anyone can join, IF they tell me they want to be there. I need your heart, not just your voice.
- Practices are from 6:30 to 8:15 (with a break) on Wednesday evenings starting September 2nd and ending with our farewell service and potluck early in January, 2021.
- Things that you can look forward to:
 - Going to Choir Camp in September at Gull Lake (so fun)
 - Visiting churches to participate in services
 - Going on tour in November (Grades 4-8)
 - Meeting seniors at Emmanuel Home on behalf of Rehoboth

To apply, you'll need to write me a letter telling me why you want to be in the choir and what you hope to contribute! This letter has to go with your application or you won't be accepted. I have put sample letters on the website under the "Kids" section.

Making Choices

1. Because **choir camp** is so important to making new friends and feeling part of the choir, we want you to make every effort to come. A parent may accompany you, if that would help you feel more comfortable.

2. **Wednesday evenings is your choir night.** We will also give you advance notice of all of our expected performances. If, on occasion, a rehearsal or performance conflicts with school or family activity, you will be allowed an excused absence but only if you call/text me beforehand. **If I find that you are missing too many rehearsals due to conflicts with sports, I will ask you to withdraw, focus on one thing and come back the following year.**

3. Remember that choir is about singing. If you don't enjoy singing maybe another activity would be more appropriate.
