

BIBLE LEADER

The Bible Leader should be equipped to lead groups in spiritual growth through discussion, sharing sessions, etc., lead evening staff devotions and should be sensitive to interpersonal relationships of both counselors and campers. The Bible Leader should be able to teach Bible truths in a simple and dynamic way.

Duties

Attend the Camp Staff Training Day each year to familiarize yourself with the Chapel material.

Arrive at camp early for orientation where you will review with the group the planned Chapel materials supplied for the week. The leader's manual will be sent to you before camp begins. Props and all other items required will be provided.

Briefly outline your plan for evening devotions (helpful to have a theme to follow for the week).

Lead counselor devotions each evening.

Be available to counselors and campers for prayer, to provide a listening ear and provide spiritual counseling if required.

At the end of the week of camp, all volunteers are asked to fill in an evaluation form which is used as a tool to measure the effectiveness of camp and for each volunteer to have an opportunity to voice any concerns. These forms are collected by the Camp Program Manager for review by the Camp Committee at the September camp wrap-up meeting.
